Since its inception in 1973, Asian Pacific Culture Week (APCW) has provided the UC Davis campus with cultural programs designed to both educate and celebrate. APCW became a University sponsored program in 1979 and has grown into an annual event anticipated by students, faculty, staff, and members of the Davis community alike. During the week, there are presentations and workshops provided by speakers about diverse issues in the Asian Pacific Islander community. In the past, musicians, comedians, actors, authors, artists, and civil rights activists have visited the campus to share their experiences.

Asian Pacific Culture Night (APCN) is the climactic finale to APCW. APCN features cultural, traditional, and modern performances by students and professional groups. These performances help reflect the changing face of Asian American culture.
