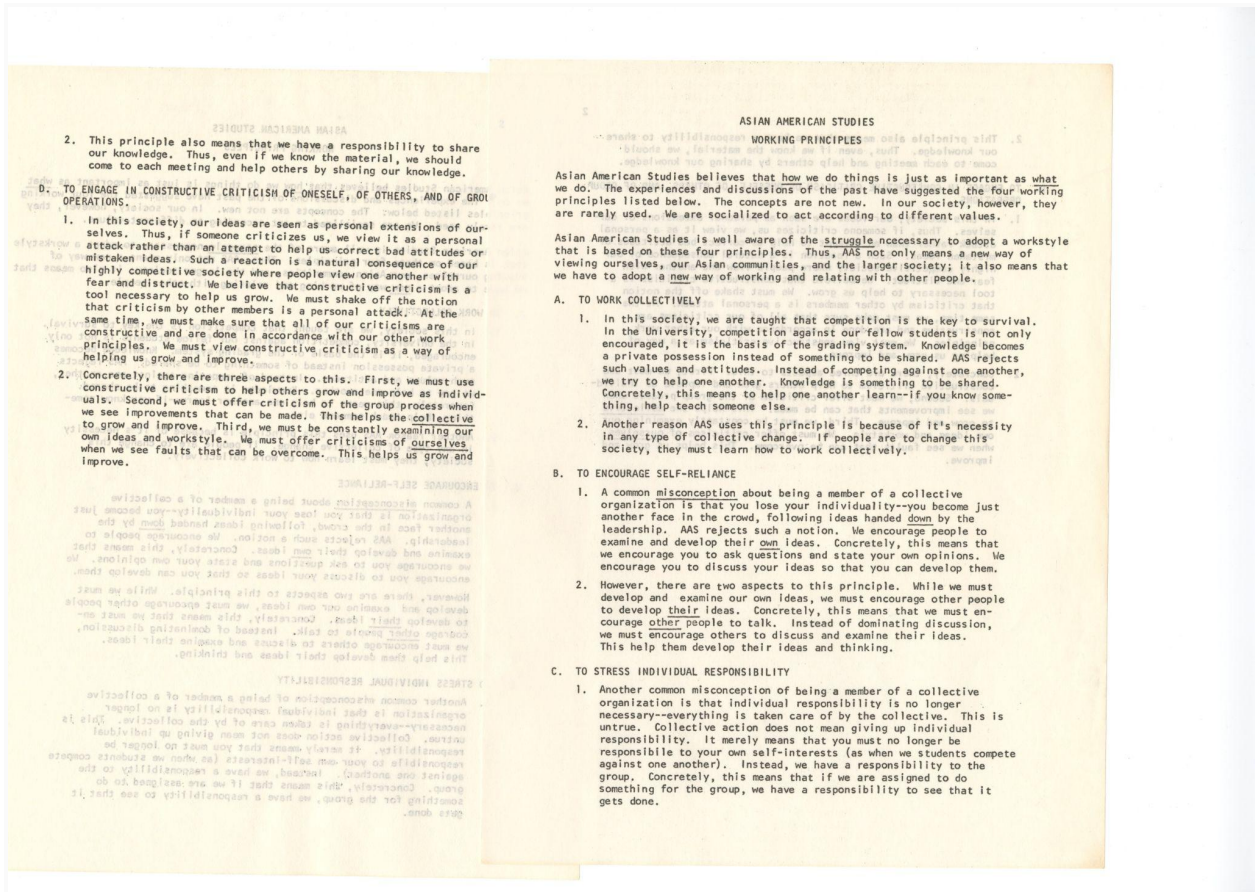

The Asian American Studies Department at the University of California, Davis was established in 1969. The cohort of professors and scholar activists who contributed to the department from

1969-1992 collected a vast array of teaching materials as they developed bibliographies, courses, and student organizations that helped contribute to the field. This collection contains the syllabi, readers, articles, newspapers, journals, loose papers, notes, letters, correspondence, research proposals, student papers, meeting notes, and fliers collected by the Asian American Studies faculty, staff, and students.
