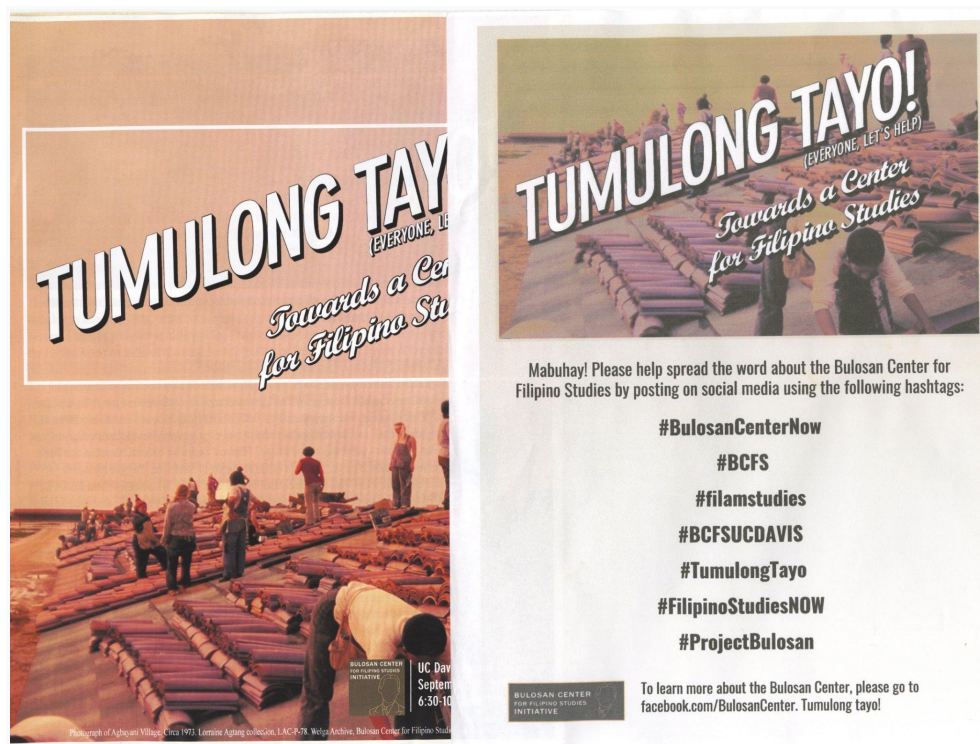

The Bulosan Center for Filipinx Studies was established in 2018 led and founded by Dr. Robyn M. Rodriguez (director) and Filipinx graduate students including Wayne Jopanda

(associate director), Jason Sarmiento (director of archives and public history), RJ Taggweg (director of research), Katherine Nasol (director of policy and community engagement), Nicholas Garcia (senior editor), and Stacey Salinas (senior historian).

The majority of the materials and paraphernalia in this collection speak to the scholar and community activism of Dr. Robyn M. Rodriguez and their collection of literary resources and engagement with local and transnational activist organizations. Other items in the collection that were collected by Dr. Rodriguez were donated by local Fil-Am communities and previous faculty members of the Asian American Studies department involved in Filipinx Studies and the Bulosan Center. The materials consist of notes, loose papers, newspapers, community journals, tapes, and files dating from 1970 to 2020. All items were previously housed in the Bulosan Center Reading Room at the Asian American Studies department.
